ORDINANCE 13.161

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES ON TOWN LAKES

The Town Board of the Town of West Bend, Washington County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: AUTHORITY. This ordinance is adopted pursuant to authority granted by Wis. Stats. §60.22 and §30.77.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE. This ordinance codifies prohibitions on commercial activities on Town lakes and assesses a penalty for violations.

SECTION 3.

ORDINANCE 13.161

Commercial Activities:

- (1) Commercial use for the purposes of this section shall include, but is not limited to, those businesses that repair or provide maintenance to boats and contractors or businesses that use the boat launch for “work barges” which carry materials such as piers, gravel, sand, stone, etc., for pier, landscaping or sea-wall business.
- (2) Commercial use of the following public boat launches shall be prohibited:
 - a. Cedar Park Drive
 - b. Hacker Drive
 - c. Paradise Drive
- (3) Commercial use of the following public boat launches shall be allowed:
 - a. Gonring Drive
- (4) Violations of this section shall be subject to penalties as defined in sec. 13.25(3) of this chapter.

ORDINANCE 13.25(1) – shall be amended as follows:

- (1) Any person who shall violate any provisions of this chapter for which a penalty is not provided in sub. (2) or sub. (3) below shall . . .

ORDINANCE 13.25(3) shall be added as follows:

- (3) Any person violating any of the provisions in sec. 13.161 of this chapter shall be fined not more than \$500, alternative 30 day maximum jail sentence on default.

This ordinance becomes effective upon passage and publication.
