

Town of West Bend Board Minutes
September 7, 2016

Chairman Paul Rice called the Town of West Bend Town Board meeting to order at 5:00 P.M.

Deputy Clerk Jennifer Rozek read the **Call of the Meeting**.

Roll Call was taken. Present: Chairman Paul Rice, Supervisor Jeff Geib, Supervisor Jim Heipp, Deputy Clerk Jennifer Rozek

The **Pledge of Allegiance** was recited.

Approval of Minutes from the August 10, 2016 Town Board meeting. Supervisor Jim Heipp made a motion to approve the minutes. Supervisor Jeff Geib seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Washington County Sheriff's Monthly Report. Deputy Craig Broker was unable to attend.

Treasurer's Report: Deputy Clerk Jennifer Rozek read the Treasurer's Report. Chairman Paul Rice made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented. Supervisor Jeff Geib seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Review of Bills and Authorization of Payments: Supervisor Jim Heipp made a motion to approve the bills and authorize payments with the exception of Check #19926 for the Tractor Rental. This amount was higher than it was agreed upon and needs to be clarified before being paid. Supervisor Jeff Geib seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion and/or Action re: Review of No Parking Signs on Maple Ridge Court and Maple Ridge Drive. The Board discussed the reasoning of placing the No Parking Signs on these Roads and gave the residents in attendance a chance to speak. After hearing the concerns Chairman Paul Rice made a motion to have all No Parking signs removed from Maple Ridge Court and the two signs placed on Maple Ridge Drive should accurately state no parking from here to intersection. Supervisor Jim Heipp seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion re: Fire Calls. There were five calls this month. Two were fires at the Learning Center within Cedar Community. Three were first time false alarms.

Granting of Bartender licenses: There were two Bartender licenses this month. Supervisor Jeff Geib made a motion to approve the license. Supervisor Jim Heipp seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Other correspondence received by the Clerk and/or Town Board to be discussed at next months meeting: Chairman Paul Rice informed the Board that Attorney Stan Riffle made contact with him this afternoon regarding the Limbach/Lagoon Lane lawsuit. A meeting will need to be scheduled to discuss what action should be taken by the Board. Supervisor Jim Heipp informed the Board a resident complained about the basin on Paradise Drive was overflowing again. When speaking with the Highway Department it was cleaned out in spring, but they will clean it out again.

Supervisor Jim Heipp made a **motion to adjourn**. Supervisor Jeff Geib seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried. Meeting was adjourned at 5:40 P.M.
